

DISPOSING OF ICONS

Each year, questions arise regarding what to do with printed materials containing icons, such as calendars, obituary cards, newsletters, etc. We should never throw any icon in the trash, regardless of the material on which it is seen. We should dispose of unwanted printed materials containing icons in one of the following ways:

- ⇒ Burn the icon and place the ashes under a tree, bush, or other place where it won't be trampled.
- ⇒ Bring **only the pages** containing the printed icons to the church and place them in the "ICON" bin outside the church offices. We will burn the icons for you.

VIRTUAL GENERAL ASSEMBLY PARTICIPATION

Our Annual Parish General Assembly is scheduled for Sunday, January 28 following the Divine Liturgy. We encourage everyone to attend in-person but are allowing physically absent members to attend via Zoom if they are classified in one of the following categories: shut-in/homebound, illness/hardship, or greater than 100 miles from St. Nicholas.

Those who are eligible to attend virtually must agree to the following:

- ♦ Complete the online registration form at <a href="strickle-stri
- ♦ Will read all emailed documents for meeting prior to attendance.
- ♦ Will login to Zoom no later than 15 minutes prior to the start of the meeting and update their screen name to read as follows: Last name, first name of all participants sharing that device's screen.
- ♦ Will have their camera running and be present in view for the entire meeting (exception restroom breaks). Note: Zoom attendees will be on the video screen for everyone to see.
- Will use the Chat function (ONLY) in Zoom for all questions and/or comments. (No verbal communication will be allowed on Zoom, only chat.)
- Will be muted the entire time and will not call or ask for proxy communication.
- ♦ Voting link will be sent in Chat along with all communication. Virtual attendees will have 10 minutes to vote.
- ♦ If not able to join due to technical support, leaving meeting early, or not being visibly present the entire time, will be considered a non-attendee.

CREATION CARE UPDATE

A small group of Calvin College biology seniors completed a plant inventory of the church property this past fall semester for their senior project. In their study they found that the quantity of native plants was unexpectedly high



compared to the non-native plants. They did still find some invasive species on the property and presented us with suggestions on how to remove them. It was a joy to see the students' passion for caring for our land!
