## THE GREAT FEAST OF THE PRESENTATION OF CHRIST

All the faithful are encouraged to attend the *Feast of the Presentation of Christ in the Temple* this Thursday, February 1 with Orthros at 4:50PM followed by Divine Liturgy at 6PM.

Because Christ is the "light to the nations" as proclaimed by St. Simeon when he received Christ into the Temple in His Presentation, **it is customary for people to bring candles to be blessed**. Your family is encouraged to bring candles to this service and place them on the table in front of the Nave. The bookstore will be open prior to the service for those who would like to purchase candles and have them blessed during the service. When the service is over and you come forward to receive a blessing, please take your blessed candles home.




