

FORGIVENESS SUNDAY

In next Sunday's Gospel reading, our Lord says: *"If you forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will forgive you; but if you do not forgive men their trespasses, neither will your heavenly father forgive you your trespasses."* (Matthew 6:14)

Heeding our Lord's teaching, at the end of next Sunday's Liturgy, we will perform the ceremony of mutual forgiveness.

FOOD FOR HUNGRY PEOPLE & CHARITABLE OUTREACH

We are now entering the 50th year of the *Food For Hungry People Program* started by Metropolitan Philip. So many people around the world have been helped by this wonderful program, but there are still so many more that need our help. Here is an excerpt from Metropolitan Philip's last address to an Archdiocese Convention Assembly, July 26, 2013:

According to the electronic media and the United Nations statistics, I would like to share with you the following facts:

- ◊ Every year, 15 million children die of hunger.
- One in 12 people worldwide is malnourished including 160 million children under the age of five.
- One out of every eight children under the age of 12 in the United States goes to bed hungry every night.

That was almost 14 years ago, and with all the atrocities happening in the world, the need is even greater today. We encourage every family to make it a Lenten priority to not only pray for those facing food scarcity but to also set an almsgiving goal and participate in our Food For Hungry People Lenten project.

HOW TO PARTICIPATE:

Show compassion on the poor and distressed. Trust in God, not yourself and ask for His help before every task this week.

Schedule a Confession. Every morning say, "Today I will be humble." Use up/freeze meats this week.

Pray facing East this week. Christ is returning from the East and we wait for Him! Use up/freeze dairy this week.

Ask each other for forgiveness each evening this week before bed.

> Bring an icon to church for a procession.

Bring a prayer rope to be blessed today! Use it and pray the Jesus Prayer each day this week.

Wear your cross to church and kiss the cross each morning with a bow!

Every time you climb stairs this week ask St. John to help you reach Paradise with the sign of the cross!

> Ask the Theotokos to offer you and the world pure thoughts and ideas this week.

> > Place your palm branches and pussywillows behind an icon at home and in your carl

Refrain from TV, Internet & Phones to honor Christ's Death.

Greet everyone with "CHRIST IS RISENI" & say it before good morning and goodnight!
