PRAYING DURING PASCHA

Hopefully, we all enjoyed a joyous "reboot" of our personal prayers with the Bright Week Paschal Office. In the weeks between Bright Week and the Leavetaking of Pascha we return to a modified version of the Trisagion Prayers, as follows:

Normal Trisagion Prayers
Glory to thee, our God, glory to thee.

O heavenly King, O Comforter, the Spirit of truth, who art in all places and fillest all things; Treasury of good things and Giver of life: Come and abide in us and cleanse us from every stain, and save our souls, O gracious Lord.

Holy God, Holy Mighty, Holy Immortal: have mercy on us. (Thrice)

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit: now and ever, and unto ages of ages. Amen.

All-holy Trinity, have mercy on us. Lord, cleanse us from our sins. Master, pardon our iniquities. Holy God, visit and heal our infirmities for thy Name's sake. Paschal Trisagion Prayers
Christ is Risen from the dead,
trampling down death by death, and
upon those in the tombs bestowing life
(three times)

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit: now and ever, and unto ages of ages. Amen.
