## **WORKS OF MERCY 2024 PARTICIPATION METRICS**

As a part of our parish Strategic Plan, for the last two years, our Works of Mercy ministry has benchmarked our participation rate as a parish (parishioners and guest/avg Sunday attendance). In the 2023 Liturgical year, 161 individuals participated in a parish sponsored Works of Mercy event. That resulted in an 84% participation rate.

In the 2024 Liturgical year, participation was up 38% with 222 individuals participating in Works of Mercy events as the parish grew in attendance by 19%. Our final participation rate in Works of Mercy events as a church was an amazing 93%.

One of the questions the strategic plan asked us to address was "would your community notice if you no longer existed?" Due to your generosity, the answer to that question is they would! Thank you for participating in the Works of Mercy events as together we "seek and share Christ's love so that all will find eternal life in Him."
